Program Regulations:

- **Registration** – The summer school registration window is **May 2 - May 13**. Students will be scheduled into classes on a first come, first served basis. Please contact Mrs. Howard at 920-986-3351 ext. 713 if you have any questions or need any assistance with registering for summer school classes.
- **Eligibility** – All students from districts within the Fox Valley Summer School Consortium are eligible to attend classes. The Consortium school districts include Appleton, Brillion, Freedom, Hilbert, Hortonville, Kaukauna, Kimberly, Little Chute, Menasha, Neenah, and Shiocton.
- **Credit Recovery and/or Credit Bearing Summer School Classes in Other Districts:** Any parent wishing to enroll a student for a credit recovery and/or a credit bearing summer school class that is OUTSIDE of their home school district should complete the registration form and turn it in to the SCHOOL THEIR STUDENT PRESENTLY ATTENDS.
- **Attendance** - Students are expected to attend summer school on a regular basis. Please contact the PK-6/Summer School Office at 920-986-3351 ext. 721 to report an absence. Absences jeopardize earning credit for high school classes. If attending high school classes in another district, please note the summer school attendance policy for that particular district.
- **Conduct** – Regular school year rules apply during summer school. Remember to *Be Safe; Be Respectful; Be Responsible . . . Be the Best That You Can Be!* Students are expected to go home when their classes end. If students attend only one or two classes, they will not be allowed to wait a long time for rides or to hang around in the school due to there being no supervision during this time.

Program Fees:

- There are no overall program fees for summer school unless your child enrolls in a class that has a fee for supplies and materials. For classes with fees, the fee amount is listed within the class information. Fees will be added to your child's account, by school personnel, once registration closes.

Individual Student Course Schedules:

- At the end of May, once you have registered and all classes are finalized, you can print out your child's schedule. Copies of individual schedules will also be available in the PK-6 Office & the lobby by the cafeteria on the first day of classes.

Canceled Classes:

- Courses may have to be canceled due to insufficient numbers or lack of staff.

Pupil Transportation:

- Student transportation to and from summer school is the parent/legal guardian's responsibility. No transportation is provided by the school district for summer school.

Grade Level:

- The grade level listed for each class refers to the grade that a student will be entering in the **FALL**.

We hope to offer students the opportunity for a reading class and a math class in order to continue building core academic skills through the month of June.

Classes Designed to Give Your Child an Extra Boost in Reading or Math (while being fun at the same time):

Course: Reading Adventures **Grade Levels 1-4**
Time: 8:00-9:00 Section 1 (Grades 1-4)
10:00-11:00 Section 2 (Grades 1-4)
Description: Come join us as we enter the world of reading. We will explore the fascinating stories of sea animals, and set our course for an hour of make-believe and fantasy. This is a great opportunity to enhance your summer reading skills, while exploring your imagination and love for books.

Course: Summer Time Math/Reading **Grade Levels 2-8**
Time: 8:00-9:00 Section 1 (Grades 2-8)
10:00-11:00 Section 2 (Grades 2-8)
11:00-12:00 Section 3 (Grades 2-8)
Description: Are you a student who would like to polish up your reading and/or math skills or extend your learning in reading or math, but be able to work independently? If so, this is the perfect class for you. Come participate in this class where a teacher will oversee a computerized program that begins by assessing your skills. Once the assessment is complete, a program will be designed to meet your specific learning needs. You will spend each day working at your own pace, earning coins to open up new levels for you to conquer. Our students love this program!

Course: Hottest Titles in Town **Grade Levels 6-8**
Time: 8:00-9:00 Section 1 (Grades 6-8)
Description: The hottest titles in town will be offered for your child's reading enjoyment. This class will also reinforce reading skills and strategies that were utilized during the school year. At the end of the course, we will close the curtain with popcorn and a movie to celebrate their success.

Enrichment and/or Physical Fitness Classes:

Course: "Summer Camp" for Incoming Four-Year-Old Kindergarten **Grade Level K4**
Time: 8:00-10:00 Section 1 (Grade K4) - *2 hour class only
10:00-12:00 Section 2 (Grade K4) - *2 hour class only
Description: This is a **two-hour class** for students who anticipate entering four-year-old kindergarten in the fall. We will explore the skills your child has and start to build readiness for starting school. If you are unsure whether or not your child is ready for Four-Year-Old Kindergarten, this is a great opportunity for you to see how he/she would do.

Course: Kindergarten Readiness for Incoming Kindergartners **Grade Level K5**
Time: 8:00-12:00 **Section 1 (Grade K5)**
Description: This class is being offered to students entering Kindergarten. Come and join us for stories, singing and dancing, practicing letters and sounds, recognizing or writing our names, and projects as we learn about what Kindergarten will be like. We hope to see you there!

Course: Cooking Kidz **Grade Levels 1-4**
Time: 9:00-10:00 **Section 1 (Grades 1-4)**

Course: Chiefs News **Grade Levels 3-8**

Other Classes Offered:

Course: Beginning Band Lessons
Date: Specific dates for lesson times will be determined by the instructor. Lessons are typically conducted in August.

Course: Middle School Accountability
Time: 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.
Description: This class is a requirement for middle school students who failed a middle school class during the year and have not yet completed the necessary "red folder" work to obtain a passing grade. Students will not be promoted to the next grade level without completion of the necessary work during summer school. Students are not allowed to participate in other summer school classes until the "red folder" work has been completed and the summer school teacher has signed off on the red folder work.

Course: High School Health (.5 credit)
Time: 9:00-10:00 Section 1 (High School)
Description: This class is for high school students who would like to earn credit for Health during the summer months. Students will have face-to-face class meeting times as well as online coursework which will need to be done independently. This class will run June through August and will be offered on a first come, first served basis. Priority will be given to students who have scheduling conflicts within the school year.
